He was happiest when introducing a new shooter to our sport. Brian was an avid hunter. His last two deer hunts despite difficult health issues, saw him successful in 2024 and a participant in 2025. He was a participant in life who cared about his club. As a Dad, he will be missed by his two girls and their families, and as a friend, by all who were privileged to know him.
